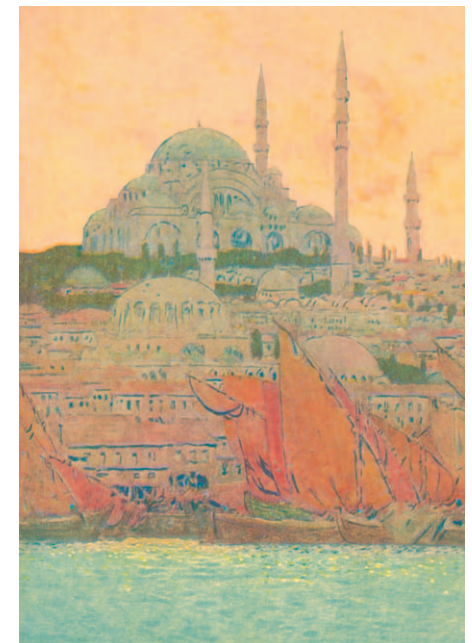

Dear Friends and Colleagues

On behalf of the Mediterranean Group for the Study of Diabetes (MGSD), I would like to welcome you to the 10th MGSD Congress that will be held in Istanbul, Turkey, April 26-29, 2007.
